St Peter's church organ is in need of repair to the blower box, which houses the motor. Without this, we have no bellows, so no wind to go through the pipes. The removal and replacement work is estimated to be around £10,000. Over the coming months we will be arranging various events to fundraise for this. Please help as much as you can. #### Boiler fund

The fundraising campaign for the church boiler was closed in June 2024 with a total amount raised £32, 154. In order for us to proceed with the church heating, we needed to have an energy audit carried out, which has been completed and we are waiting on a detailed report from the diocese with a plan of action in order for us to move forward. We are looking for an electric heating solution so that we can move away from fossil fuels in line with the Church of England target to achieve net-zero carbon by 2030.

We are currently looking into the HALO Church heating system by HERSCHEL. The infrared Halo heaters provide an efficient, sustainable, non-intrusive and comfortable radiant heating solution.
